## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Where is the Freedom Festival held?

*The County of College of Morris, 214 Center Grove Rd., Randolph, NJ 07869*

### Is there a deadline to submit applications/payment for booth?

**YES**, Registration closes on **Wednesday, May 30th**. Mail payment and completed contract to: **Bonnie Hodge, Kiwanis Club of Randolph Kiwanis, Inc., PO Box 106, Mt. Freedom, NJ 07970**.

### Do I have to be there all three days?

**YES**, Vendors who fail to participate all three days for any reason, forfeit booth location/fees. Breaking down early or opening up late, unless approved in advance is prohibited.

### Is it rain or shine?

**YES**, dangerous weather conditions may cause the ride company or the Township to shut down the rides. In that event, the duration and severity of the storm may end the festival for the day.

### Is there a rain date?

**YES**, if all or any part of the Festival on Saturday, July 1st is called for rain, the advertised rain date (including the Fireworks display) is **Sunday, July 1st**. All vendors, including our ride and game vendors, will be required to set up on the rain date.

### What time can I arrive on June 28th to set up?

Arrive between **12:00pm-4:00pm**. **Vehicles must be removed from isles by 4:30pm.**

### What is a 9' x 20' space?

*The size of a standard parking space. We realize most vendors utilize 10x10 tents and will take that into consideration in finalizing our floor plan.*

**Is Electricity included?** **Only SOOW grade extension cords will be permitted** per NJ State. Vendors can utilize self supplied battery powered lighting, provide their own SOOW cord or Rent an SOOW cord for the rate of \$25.00 for the weekend. If utilizing electricity, vendors are a **LIMITED to ONE standard household (120 Volt/15 Amp)hook-up/per booth for overhead lighting only. NO standard household extension cords, power strips, fans.** Vendors arriving without the appropriate equipment **will not have access to electricity.**

**What size tent do most people set up?**

*A 10' x 10' pop-up tent. **Each vendor is responsible for anchoring their tents with sand bags and/or cinder blocks to ensure everyone's safety.***

**Can we leave our items overnight and is there security?**

*Booths, tables and chairs, etc., can be left overnight and there is general security but nothing of value should be left overnight. The Festival will not be responsible for damage, theft or loss of any vendor's work, personal property or display.*

**Is there running water and ATMS? **NO****
